“SiteCall” Wireless Communications for the Construction Industry

Battery-powered Ritron Callboxes put wireless voice communication right where it is needed, without costly installation fees associated with hard-wired systems. Callboxes provide security, promote safety and improve productivity on every job-site, simply and cost effectively.

Ritron has developed a wireless 2-Way Radio Callbox that simplifies job-site communication and generates profit dollars over and over again. The contractor pays for them once and turns future jobsite communication expenses into profit generators. He owns them; he installs them; he moves them to the next job.

Callboxes can be programmed and used with most existing VHF or UHF business band radios. Electricians and telephone installers are not required because electrical wires and telephone cables are not utilized. In high-rise jobsites, Callboxes are used for rapid deployment of man-lift elevators to each floor. They are added in minutes to floors as they are being built. Basic models are used where only employees are allowed. Tamper resistant XT models are ideal for areas where the “public” is present.

Normally, a Callbox is powered with 6 D-cell alkaline batteries. The unit is off until the person calling pushes the talk button. (Imagine it as a stationary walkie-talkie; push and hold-to-talk, release to listen.) After the conversation is finished, the Callbox automatically shuts off to conserve batteries, and thus, one set of batteries provides thousands of transmissions. Moreover, Callboxes can be AC powered, when necessary, by using a RPS-EXPO power supply. The Callbox can then be left on 24/7.
